



## Preschool Policies

### Bed Babies, Creepers, and Toddlers

- Please bring your child's bag with the items listed below LABELED:
  - Pacifiers, bottles and cups
  - Diapers and extra clothes
  - Snacks
- Babies will be fed milk, juice or water as provided by parents. Time and circumstances do not allow for spoon feeding.
- Bring pre-measured formula mix in bottle. Nursing mothers should supply 4 oz. of milk or formula.
- Please provide pullups or diapers (we supply wet wipes) and an extra change of clothes.
- Please fill out an information sheet at the door, for feeding times and instructions.
- Age-appropriate, snacks are provided.
- A nursing room is provided for you.

### Two's, Three's, and Four's

- Personal toys should be left at home.
- Bring bag with child's cup, pullups and change of clothes, labeled.

### Health Policies

To protect your child and other children, children need to be **free of fever and without fever reducing medication for 24 hours** before coming into contact with other children.

A child should not be brought to church when the following exists:

- Common Cold (green, runny nose)
- Fever (must be free of fever for 24 hours)
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea (for any reason) within the previous 24 hours
- Any symptom of the usual childhood diseases - scarlet fever, chicken pox, etc.
- Sore throat
- Croup/frequent cough
- Any unexplained rash
- Any skin infection - boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Pink eye and other eye infections

If your child comes down with an infectious disease within 24 hours of attending, please inform the Director of Preschool Ministries at 281-391-1100.
